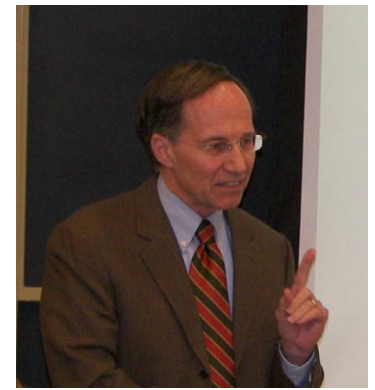
## Many Thanks to our Outstanding Fall Speakers
