"The DEN fosters and promotes entrepreneurship among students, faculty, clinicians, researchers, staff, alumni, and community members from all schools at Dartmouth, the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center (DHMC), and the Dartmouth Regional Technology Center (DRTC).
